Moderna-Spikevax COVID-19 Vaccine Benefits & Risks

Understand the risks and benefits of receiving the two-dose Moderna-Spikevax COVID-19 vaccine, which may prevent you from getting COVID-19. Talk to the vaccination provider if you have questions.

WHO CAN RECEIVE THIS VACCINE?

The Moderna-Spikevax vaccine is recommended for people 18 years and older.

ABOUT THIS VACCINE

This vaccine has been fully approved by the FDA for those 18 years and older. This vaccine is a two-dose series, given 28 days apart, injected into the muscle.

Before Getting the Vaccine

Tell the vaccination provider about all your medical conditions, including if you:

- have any allergies
- have a fever
- have a bleeding disorder or are on a blood thinner
- are immunocompromised or are on a medicine that affects your immune system
- are pregnant, breastfeeding, or plan to become pregnant
- have received another COVID-19 vaccine

RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS VACCINE

General Side Effects: Side effects reported with this vaccine include injection site reactions, fatigue, headache, muscle pain, joint pain, chills, nausea and vomiting, and fever.

Severe Allergic Reaction: There is a remote chance the vaccine could cause a severe allergic reaction (difficulty breathing, swelling of face and throat, fast heartbeat, bad rash all over your body, dizziness, weakness), which would usually occur a few minutes to one hour after getting the dose.

BENEFITS OF THIS VACCINE

COVID 19-vaccines effectively lower your risk of getting and spreading the virus that causes COVID-19. COVID-19 vaccines reduce the risk of serious illness, hospitalization and death idue to COVID-19.

WHY DO I NEED A BOOSTER?

Recent data suggest all COVID-19 vaccines become less effective at preventing infection or severe illness over time, especially for people ages 65 years and older.

Those who received a primary series of the Moderna-Spikevax vaccine should get a booster dose of either of the mRNA vaccines—Pfizer-BioNTech Comirnaty or Moderna-Spikevax—at least 5 months after completing the primary series.

YOU SHOULD NOT GET THIS VACCINE IF:

You had a severe allergic reaction to any ingredient of this vaccine: messenger ribonucleic acid (mrna), lipids (sm-102, polyethylene glycol [peg] 2000 dimyristoyl glycerol [dmg], cholesterol, and 1,2-distearoyl-sn-glycero-3-phosphocholine [dspc]), tromethamine, tromethamine hydrochloride, acetic acid, sodium acetate trihydrate, and sucrose.

If you experience a severe allergic reaction:

Call 9-1-1, or go to the nearest hospital. Call the vaccination provider or your health care provider if you have persistent or unexpected side effects.
